As the SOA Regional Representative for Southeast Asia, you will have a broad set of responsibilities including but not limited to:

- Identify and engage young ocean leaders
- Facilitate and support in the development of Ocean Leadership Hubs and their global presence
- Serve as the primary point of contact for geographic specific activities
- Identify and engage potential mentors for our global community
- Facilitate regional community building activities like community calls, events, and trainings
- Identify and engage with potential partners in governmental, NGO, for profit, community based, university, press, and other strategically important organizations.
- Accurately and regularly update SOA contact and relationship management system with partners, organizations, leaders, mentors, and other stakeholders
- Support regional social media account for the region and support hubs in doing the same
- Provide support and guidance in regional SOA online presence (hubs, ambassadors, community)
- Ensure relevant contacts remain aware of SOA activities and campaigns
- Identify and facilitate the creation of opportunities for the SOA community
- Provide regionally relevant policy advice and support SOA Policy and YPAC campaigns
- Support in the development and management of regional microgrants
- Work with staff to develop content to support in community development
- Support SOA staff on virtual, international, and major events
- Be an advocate for youth leadership development and planetary wellbeing
- Regularly attend calls with the global group and staff contact

This is a part time contract position starting at 40 hours per month (avg 10/week) starting immediately.
